Meet the Presenter

Find out how Ahman Green went from the trading block to the record books. Ahman will discuss the rollercoaster start to his career, how he was able to find success with Green Bay and his fondest memories from his time with the Packers.

About Our Speaker: Ahman Green is the Green Bay Packers' all-time leading rusher, four time Pro Bowl performer and member of the Green Bay Packers' Hall of Fame. Green spent eight of his 12 years as a pro in the green and gold, amassing six 1,000 yard seasons and 33 games in which he rushed for over 100 yards. In 2003 he had one of the best seasons by a running back in NFL history, rushing for an amazing 1,883 yards and 15 touchdowns.

Since retiring from the NFL in 2009, Green has worked to pursue his interests outside of football including acting, sports media and health and fitness training.

As an actor, Green was selected from 150 applicants to participate in the NFL's first ever "Pro Hollywood Boot Camp," and later landed a role in the Rob Schneider film "Big Stan." Green is currently working on several new film projects both as an actor and producer, while also serving as a co-host and analyst for WFRV TV in Green Bay for television programming broadcast statewide in Wisconsin. Green has also worked as a sideline analyst for the Big Ten Network and frequently joins national television and radio programs to share unique insights gleaned from his record-setting career.

Noted for his superior strength, endurance and durability during his playing days, Green maintains a healthy lifestyle and helps others do the same as a certified personal trainer. Green launched a D1 training facility in Green Bay, joining an elite group of current and former professional athletes under the D1 umbrella, including Peyton Manning, Chipper Jones, Tim Tebow and Herschel Walker.

Green is the proud parent of 5 children. When he is not busy acting, working out, playing rugby or spending time with his family, Green enjoys donating his time to several charities including the Boys and Girls Club, Children's Hospital and the Alzheimer's Association of Greater Wisconsin.
